Lessons from the Road

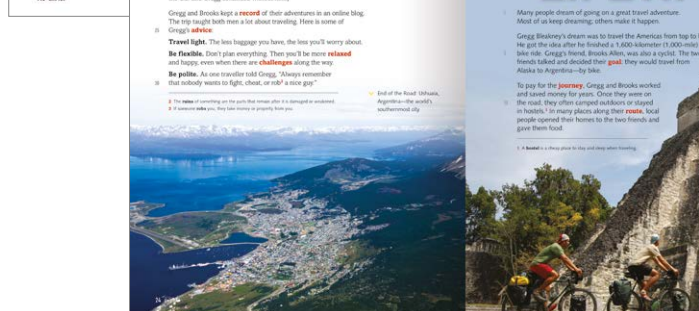
Gregg and Brooks kept a record of their adventures in an online blog. The trip taught both men a lot about traveling. Here is some of Gregg's advice:

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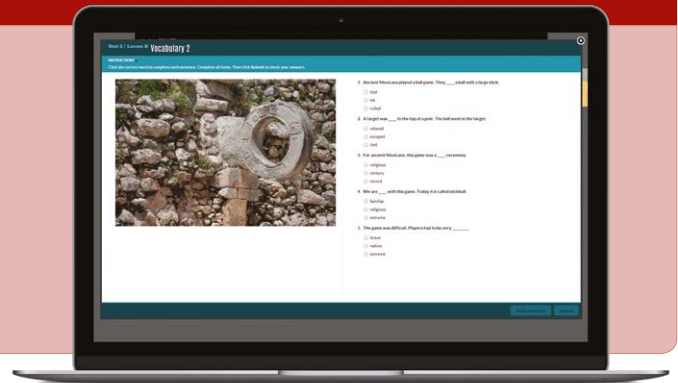

IN ONE CUBIC FOOT

Around us there are millions of tiny **bees**, plants, insects, fish, and other animals, but we rarely see them. Most of these **organisms** live in the soil, or like the ones pictured in the water. Some are only a centimeter in size.

1. In any **environment**—forest, mountain, water—you always see the big animals first: birds, mammals, fish.
